# To be a good neighbour to people in need, to challenge injustice and to be friends with people of other cultures and faiths

- supporting the Anna Chaplaincy and children & families work and activities;
- o supporting mission at Cornerstone House in Salisbury Village;
- supporting local groups such as Centre 33, the Living Room, Open Door and the Winter Beds Project, FEED, interfaith networks;
- supporting Christian Aid, Action for Children, All We Can and the Fund for Human Need
- o organising Holiday at Home seniors' holiday club;
- engaging in the Methodist Church 'Walking with Micah' and supporting our Justice & Peace group activities

# To show and tell the good news of Jesus Christ to make more followers for Him

- o support work with children & families
- o support the work of the Anna Chaplain
- continue and extend our Chatterbox coffee morning and Toddlers outreach;
- take advantage of opportunities to demonstrate and share our faith with premises users and visitors;
- o increase our engagement with our local community.

### To help people grow and learn as Christians through teaching, spiritual development, mutual support and care

- continue our current pastoral care system; to train and nurture and encourage pastoral visitors in their work;
- continue informal gatherings and fellowship groups to help people to get to know one another better;
- support our young people and the Junior Church;
- encourage existing and plan to create more small groups e.g. bible study groups;
- o support Lent groups and Circuit Study and Quiet days;
- look at new ways in which we can enhance the spiritual development of the congregation and the community, e.g. Thursday Thinking Lunches programme includes spiritual topics as well as justice and peace topics.

## To build partnerships with other churches and groups who share some of our mission aims

- extend working jointly with Hatfield Road Methodist Church as 'St Albans Methodists', building on the foundations of the lay worker project partnership;
- o maintain and strengthen our relationship with St Peter's;
- develop our relationship with the Church of God of Prophecy, who share our building;
- o support the ecumenical work of our Anna Chaplain;
- o maintain links with city centre churches and Churches Together;
- o support our Circuit and its churches.

### To increase awareness of God's presence and to celebrate God's love in worship.

- o hold regular Sunday morning worship at 10.30am;
- hold seasonal invitational services such as All Souls and Carol Service, Brownie Parades and Holiday Club Celebration;
- support the Anna Chaplaincy weekday afternoon services;
- take opportunities to share in worship at the Cathedral, St Peter's and Hatfield Road and to be joined by their congregations for worship at MRMC;
- o develop our online profile and outreach.
